Dear Viking Student and Parent/Guardian,

Please be sure to read this letter very carefully!

Annual Verification: An email was sent to all families detailing the process for updating the emergency card for your student. It is imperative that you access your ParentVue account and update the information. In order to complete registration for your student, you will need to have all information updated. Thank you in advance for your attention to this change.

Registration Information

You must have your Annual Verification updated prior to registering your student. During registration, students will pick up their schedules, locker assignments, textbooks, planners, and etc. (please note we will not be taking pictures during our registration dates. We have school pictures scheduled for September 19th during the school day. Students may also purchase locker shelves, school yearbook and PE shirts during these times.

The following are scheduled dates and times for students to come to Van Hoosen for registration:

- 8th grade only -Tuesday, August 16th, 9:00–11:00 AM, (last name A-L) & 12:00-2:00 (M-Z)
- 7th grade only –Wednesday, August 17th, 9:00 11:00 AM, (last name A-L) & 12:00-2:00 (M-Z)
- 6th grade only –Thursday, August 18th, 8:30 –11:30 AM Viking Games 1:00 – 3:00 PM, 6th grade (student only) See page 4 for more information.

If you cannot come to registration on the above dates, <u>late registration will take place August 22 from 9:00 AM -2:00 PM</u>, <u>August 24 from 12:00 PM -2:00 PM</u>, and <u>August 26 from 9:00 AM - 2:00 PM</u>. Students not able to attend registration or late registration will have to complete the process the first day of school.

Medical Action Plans

We are committed to ensuring the health and safety of all students! Updated Medical Action Plans (MAPs), are required at the start of every school year. MAPs provide Van Hoosen staff with direction about any medical needs such as medication administration, medical interventions and chronic conditions. Students who take medication at school or who carry medical supplies such as Epi-pens, insulin, rescue inhalers, etc. are required to have a MAP on file.

All MAP forms may be found on the district website under Health & Wellness. They must be filled out completely and signed by your health care provider. Signed MAPs may be delivered along with any medications to the school office between August 15-26. We cannot accept medications without a signed MAP form or MAP forms without a physician signature.

Many MAPs are dropped off during registration. If you need to speak with staff, please consider coming outside of the registration times. If you are new to the district and your student has a medical condition that is dependent on staff support, please contact the school directly prior to school start.
